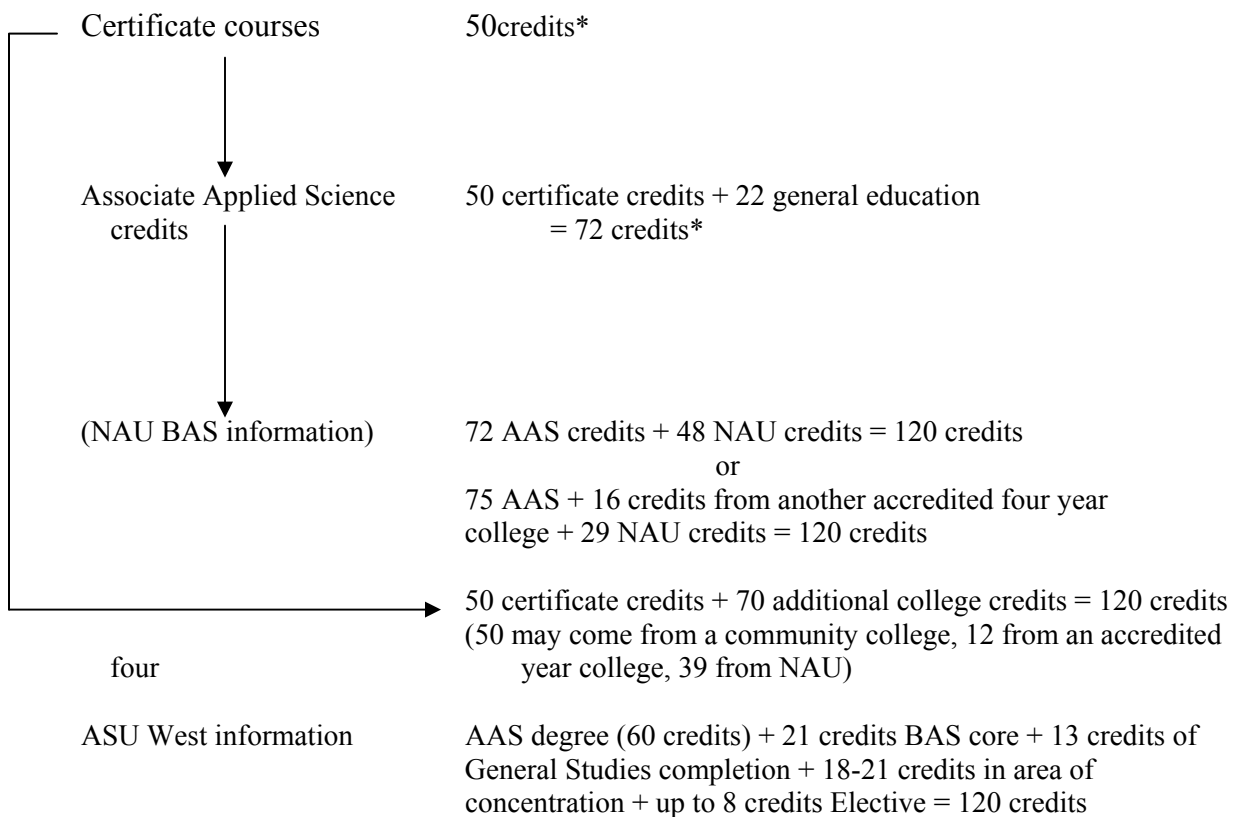


CLINICAL LABORATORY SCIENCES

The Clinical Laboratory Sciences program provides training for students to become Clinical Laboratory Technicians (CLT's). Clinical or medical Laboratory Technicians provide clinical information to physicians, pathologists, researchers, and other healthcare providers by conducting a variety of tests on various specimens submitted to clinical or research laboratories. CLT's perform general tests in all laboratory areas such as blood banking, chemistry, hematology, immunology, and microbiology. CLT's perform laboratory testing in many clinical settings such as hospitals, reference laboratories, clinics, and bioscience industry. Phoenix College offers a certificate and an associate degree in clinical laboratory sciences.
