# Credit by Exam

## Health Core Curriculum Credit by Examination

The HCC credit by examination option offers students the opportunity to complete tests and apply for credit for the Maricopa Community Colleges' Health Core Curriculum (HCC) Courses. Credits for the HCC courses may be obtained by taking and passing the HCC Competency Assessment Test (CATS).

### Assessment Test Available

#### HCC130 Series:

HCC130AA, HCC130AB, HCC130AC, HCC130AD, HCC130AE, HCC130AF

Successfully completing exams for all six modules (listed above) is required to obtain credit for HCC130.

#### HCC145 Series:

HCC145AA, HCC145AB, HCC145AC

Successfully completing exams HCC145AA and HCC145AB is required to obtain credit for HCC146. Successfully completing exams HCC145AA, HCC145AB and HCC145AC is required to obtain credit for HCC145.

After successfully completing an exam with a passing score of 75% or better, the student is eligible to apply for credit for the appropriate corresponding Maricopa Community Colleges' Health Core Curriculum course.

**NOTE: This is a one-time option. You may take each exam only once.**

## Health Core Curriculum Test Content

HCC Competency Assessment Tests were developed by the Integrated Competency Assessment Network (ICAN) in conjunction with faculty content experts. Typically, each exam module is a 60 question multiple choice test and the student is typically allotted 75 minutes to complete an exam. Test questions cover a wide variety of content directly related to all of the course competencies.

## Testing Process

## Results and Retesting Information:

Students may take an exam only one time. The student must score 75% or better to pass each exam.

## Students may not:

- Take the same HCC test at another official testing site.
- Challenge a course while currently enrolled in the course.
- Establish credit in a previously completed course.
- Establish credit for lower level of a course in which credits have been received.
- Request a refund after the exam has been administered, regardless of the results.

A student may take only take one HCC exam at a time. Students with disabilities should contact the Disability Resources and Services office on campus for any questions regarding testing accommodations.
