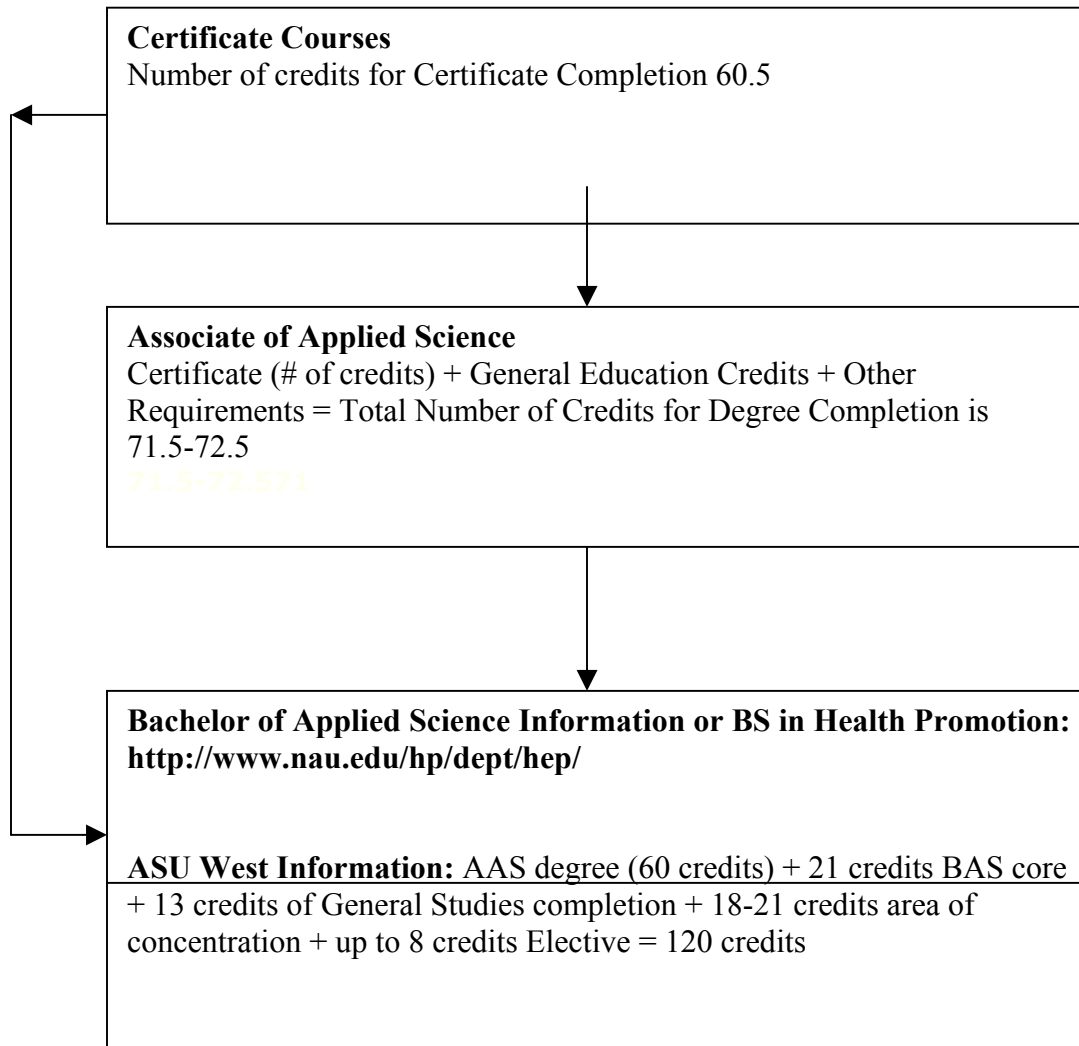


Diagnostic Medical Ultrasound

Diagnostic Medical Ultrasonographers are also known as Sonographers. Sonographers operate sophisticated ultrasound imaging equipment under the direction of a Medical Doctor. Ultrasound creates localized images of the patient's anatomy to assist doctors in diagnosing medical problems. Sonographers must have patient care skills in order to explain the procedure to patients, position them correctly, and perform the sonographic examination. Additionally, Sonographers must be knowledgeable about disease processes, pathology, sterile procedures, and the care and maintenance of ultrasound equipment.
